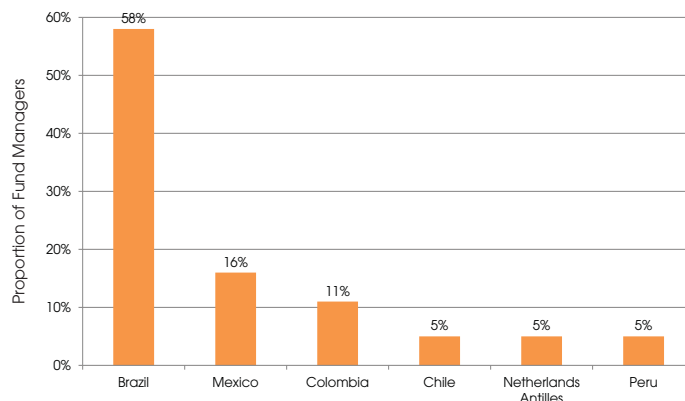

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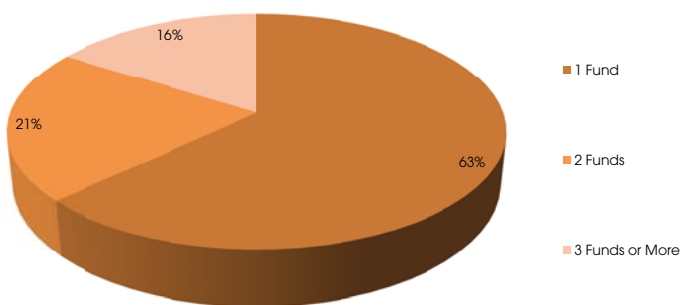
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Fig. 2: Breakdown of Central and South America-Based Infrastructure Fund Managers by Country



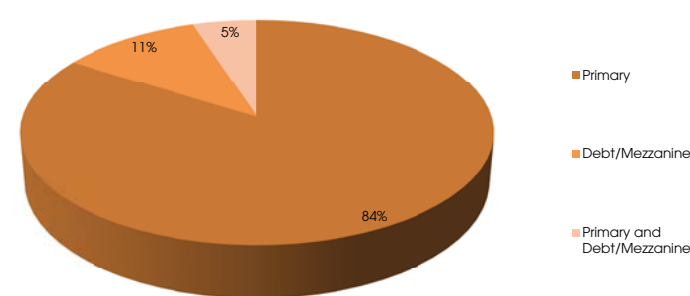
